Use the remittance slip sent by Revenu Québec.

If you hold a licence under the International Fuel Tax Agreement (IFTA), you must file quarterly returns as of the date your licence is issued and for as long as your licence is valid, **even if you did not travel or have no tax to pay.**

Steps to follow

1. Complete a copy of Parts 2 and 3 for each type of fuel used. Use the data pertaining to qualified motor vehicles for which decals or a temporary permit was issued.
2. As applicable, amount T or the total of amounts T from the copy or copies of the work chart in Part 3 completed for each type of fuel used must be carried to the corresponding line of your quarterly return (Part 1).
3. Send the quarterly return, duly completed and signed, to Revenu Québec, along with Parts 2 and 3, regardless of the method of payment.
4. Make your payment, if applicable.

Method of payment

You may make your payment at a financial institution, in person at Revenu Québec or by mail (enclose the **remittance slip sent by Revenu Québec**). If paying at Revenu Québec or by mail, you must remit a cheque or a money order, payable to the Minister of Revenue. Write your IFTA number on the cheque or money order.

Filing and payment deadline

The return and payment (if applicable) must be submitted to Revenu Québec by the due date indicated on the return. This date is the last day of the month following the period covered by the return.

Date on which a return is received

The date on which a return is received is

- the date of the Revenu Québec stamp if you submit your return in person; or
- the date of the postmark if you mail the return.

Date on which a payment is received

The date on which a payment is received is the date of the Revenu Québec stamp, whether the payment is mailed or remitted in person.

Interest

You must pay interest on any amount of tax that is not paid by the due date. Interest rates are shown on form CAR-512.1-V.

Late-filing penalty

If you file your return after the due date or if an amount of tax remains unpaid after that date, you must pay a penalty equal to the higher of the following amounts:

- \$50; or
- 10% of the total amount of tax payable for each type of fuel reported.

Please note that the balance due used to calculate the penalty cannot be reduced by any credit in reserve.
